








Thursday May 25 Misc. flushing points to complete the job

Some roads listed above will only be flushed lightly due to the distances to the existing flushing valves.

During these three days, all property owners may experience low water pressure and discolored water. Please refrain from doing laundry! The entire community will experience some if not all of these over the three days. Even if not in the targeted area!

Measures that can be taken by property owners during flushing to help!

Minimize water use during active flushing times 9 am – 4pm

If water is discolored after flushing time run outside hose spigot till clear this will lessen discolored water consequences your home.

Refrain from drinking till water is clear (note: water *will* be safe for consumption at all times-discoloration is just esthetics.)

If you have running toilets or leaking faucets, discolored water will enter your home continuously. Important to fix them they can't be fixed before flushing turn off water valve to prevent problem.

Using excessive amounts of hot water will pull discolored water into water heater.
