Who is eligible?

- Competition is open to high school seniors who will be entering an accredited post-secondary education program (either college or vocational program) in 2024.
- Children and grandchildren of property owners in good standing are eligible.
- Applicants must be legally residing within the United States.

How much is the Scholarship Award?

- There will be up to six \$1,000 scholarships awarded. One scholarship to an applicant attending an accredited college, one to an applicant attending an accredited vocational program, and the others to the best qualified of the remaining applicants. **The scholarship award will be sent directly to the institution at which the recipient is enrolled** and will be credited to the recipient's account for use in accordance with the scholarship policy of the institution. The awards may be used for tuition, books, or, any approved expense relative to student's education, subject to the approval of the Financial Officer of the institution.

How are recipients selected?

- Scholarship selections are based on the applicant's academic record, demonstrated leadership ability in school and community activities, work experience, and a statement of goals and aspirations.

When will applicants be notified of the awards?

- Applicants awarded the Scholarship will be notified by June 1, 2024. Awards will be presented at the Annual Property Owners Meeting on June 13, 2024.

How to apply:

Each qualified student must –

1. Complete and sign application.
2. Have an official high school transcript forwarded to the WLE Scholarship Committee.
Transcript must be submitted directly from the school.
3. Return all application materials by May 1, 2024 to the attention of the WLE Scholarship Committee.
