#### 2024 Golf Cart Test Dates



In order to sign up for the Golf Cart Test you must:

- be 12 years old at the time of the driving test
- obtain the booklet to study either from the office or online <a href="https://wleonline.org/site/rv/">https://wleonline.org/site/rv/</a>
- show proof of age (no exceptions)
- you must make an appointment to take the written portion of the test available on Mon, Wed, Thurs, Fri and Sat.
- · ~once you pass the written portion you must sign up in the office and obtain a date for the driving portion at which time you will also receive the practice permit
- pay the \$25 fee at time of sign up
- · must have a parent/guardian present at time of signing up

You may sign up six months before the test date for your practice permit provided the child is 12 at the time of
