2024 Golf Cart Test Dates



In order to sign up for the Golf Cart Test you must:

- be 12 years old at the time of the driving test
- obtain the booklet to study either from the office or online <https://wleonline.org/site/rv/>
- show proof of age (no exceptions)
- you must make an appointment to take the written portion of the test available on Mon, Wed, Thurs, Fri and Sat. at 10am
- -once you pass the written portion you must sign up in the office and obtain a date for the driving portion at which time you will also receive the practice permit
- pay the \$25 fee at time of sign up
- must have a parent/guardian present at time of signing up

You may sign up six months before the test date for your practice permit provided the child is 12 at the time of the driving test

Driving Test Dates are as follows April-September 2024:

- *Every Tuesday 10:00am, 10:30am, 11:00am, 11:30am
- *Every Saturday 8:00-11:00am, on 30 minute intervals
- *Every Sunday 8:00-11:00am, on 30 minute intervals
- *Dates are subject to change based on weather or Holidays.

Written Test Dates are as follows April-September 2024:

Monday/Wednesday/Thursday/Friday/Saturday - 10am - three slots per day
